LUCY KIRKWOOD - PLAYWRIGHT

Lucy Kirkwood is an acclaimed playwright and screenwriter.

Recent work includes *MOSQUITOES* (presented by special arrangement with Manhattan Theatre Club), which opened at the National Theatre, London, in summer 2017; and *THE CHILDREN*, which premiered at the Royal Court Theatre, London, in 2016. *THE CHILDREN* opened on Broadway in December 2017.

Lucy also writes for screen: She has written for "Skins" (Company Pictures); created and wrote "The Smoke" (Kudos/Sky 1); wrote and directed the short film "The Briny"; and is developing projects with Raw TV, Cowboy Films, Clio Barnard, and Lenny Abrahamson.



MATTHEW DIESCH - DIRECTOR

Matthew is an actor, director, intimacy advisor and photographer.

He was a founding member of the Acting Collective and Crossfade Productions. He has directed at Howick Little Theatre, Auckland Fringe and the Short and Sweet Festival.

Recent credits include playing Siegfried Sassoon in *Not About Heroes*, Frank in *Educating Rita*, Jack Gale in *The Thrill of Love* and directing the brilliant Lucy Kirkwood play *NSFW* for Howick Little Theatre.

This is his third play with Foolish Wit after playing Governor Danforth in *The Crucible* and Arthur in *An Unseasonable Fall of Snow*.

Julia has experience in most areas of theatre but has a clear favourite in technical design. Julia especially loves creating unconventional designs in unconventional spaces and digging deep into the meat of a good story.


